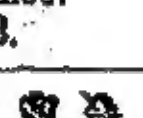

QUARANTINE AT EGYPTIAN AND CONTINENTAL PORTS.

ARRANGEMENTS have been made for the use of the Company's Steamers through the Suez Canal in Quarantine, thus avoiding any detention in EGYPT.
