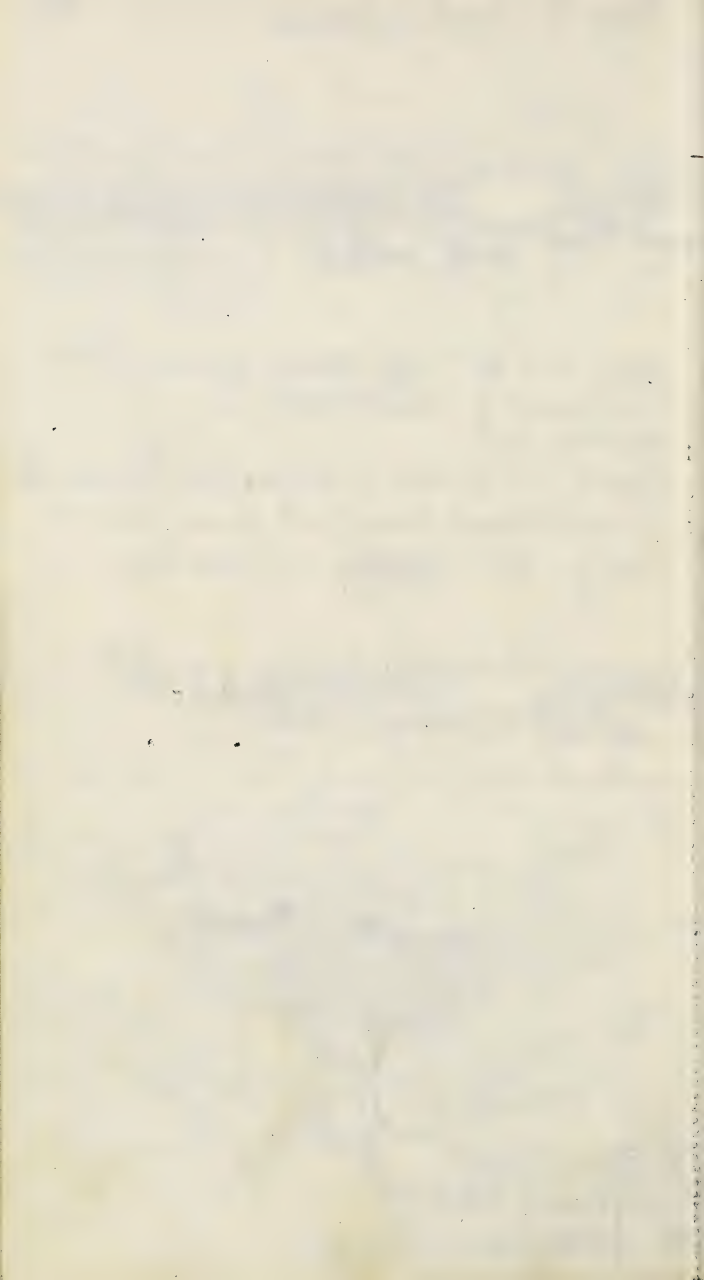




1. above A - B Ridge densely massed (like a pavement of white mounds!)
